Every year on the feast of the Holy Trinity, we are reminded of the mystery of community and friendship. Both of these great gifts in our lives come from a reflection on the nature of the Trinity - three persons, one God, each giving and receiving love from the other! These relationships between the three Persons of the Trinity are the most intimate, most intense, most loving that anyone could ever imagine!

Our God is a community of persons and yet still only one God! This is the ultimate mystery. This is a mystery that we cannot even begin to understand, and yet in our own lives we know in a kind of intuitive way that, yes, this must be true. God must be somehow a community because our own deepest needs are always calling us to love and to friendship. We, who are made in the image of God, are called to love and to be loved.

This means that the work of building community and friendship is a sacred work. And so, loving is the first way that we grow in the image of God. It is so important to convince ourselves that loving is the most important thing that we can do! If we hold it up as the one thing that we all must be about, then perhaps we will be able to really gain some balance in our lives - not putting work or efficiency, or possessions or play ahead of it! This week, ask to know the gift of communal love!

We will celebrate the birth of our Spiritually Adopted babies in **July** with a Baby Shower for BirthRight Crisis Pregnancy Center. Please watch the bulletin for information. Meanwhile, don't let up on your prayers for your personal "Little One." He/she is still in danger of abortion during these last weeks of his/her pre-born life!

The following text is on the poster:

Eighth and Ninth Months (size: about 18 inches)

In the last two months the baby continues to gain weight. She is developing a layer of fat that will keep her warm after birth. In the 9<sup>th</sup> month she will shift to a head-down position, preparing for birth. Her lungs are now fully developed and capable of making the transition to breathing air. After birth she will continue the human growth process for approximately the next 80 years.

## PARISH INFORMATION

### CHURCH RENOVATIONS

We will be doing renovations to the outside of the church. There will be three projects – painting the outside including the bell tower, replacing the loose slates on the roof and bell tower and the demolition of the chimney.

As you can see the painting project has begun and it could take approximately 4 to 5 weeks.

The repairs to the roof will take place while the painting is being accomplished

The demolition of the chimney is necessary because it is getting cracks in it and also it so not very attractive. We hope this will be completed within a week, but no guarantee. Each block is taken down one by one. We do not have a start date as of now.

During this time period, especially taking down the chimney, the handicapped ramp will be roped off and cannot be used for safety precautions.

We will keep you informed of dates and times as soon as we have them. I ask you to be patient and understanding during this renovation period.
